The Expert Group on Social Impact Assessment by Meghalaya Institute of Governance on Integrated Facilitation Centre and Exit Point at Boldamgre, Junjuni, South West Garo Hills held its meeting in the Conference Room of the Circuit House, Ampati on 01-09-2017 and again in the conference room of the Department of Rural Development and Agriculture Production, North Eastern Hill University on 08-09-2017 at 12:00 hours. Both the meetings were chaired by Dr.S.C.Srivastava, Professor, Department of Rural Development and Agricultural Production. All the eight members, namely Mr.R. C. Momin, BDO, Zikzak, Marquish Marak, VEC Secretary, Benitha Marak, Boldamgre women representative, A.W.M. Sangma, Assistant Director of Agriculture, South West Garo Hills District, Janardan Koch Assistant Director, Seva Bharati, W.A.Sangma Divisional Soil and Water Conservation Officer, South West Garo Hills and Fr.Sunny Joseph Mavelil, Director, Bakdil NGO.

The Expert Group accepted in principle the Social Impact Assessment Report prepared by the Meghalaya Institute of Governance as the benefits of the proposed project namely setting up of Integrated Facilitation Centre Entry and Exit Point at Junjuni for the project far outweighs the costs involved.

After due and diligent consideration the Expert Group is confident that the above mentioned project will control infiltration, regulate markets and result in better prices for agricultural products and may also generate revenue for the state.

As there is only one owner of the proposed land to be acquired and since she also does not stay at the proposed site, there are no costs involved in rehabilitation. At present there is only one lady with seven children staying in the project site running a tea shop. She can be shifted from the proposed project site and her services may be utilized near the entry and exit point where some business dwellings are likely to come up with setting up of the entry and exit point.

The project will not only check infiltration but is also likely to increase tourism and other economic activities

Since no one other than the tea shop owner stays in the proposed project site not much compensation is involved except for providing rehabilitation to the shop owner with appropriate packages.

The project has an added advantage as there are two buildings adjacent to the project site which may be used by Government of Meghalaya or Department of Tourism. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the chair.
