

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 CrPC

Dated Ampati, the 2nd April, 2020

No. PA/DCA/DTFI-COVID-19/65/2020/101, Whereas, multiple COVID-19 cases detected in the neighbouring State of Assam is getting out of control,

And Whereas, despite lockdown, there are movement of vehicles from Assam and within the district without valid permits,

And Whereas, the COVID-19 problem is a question of life and death, public health and safety and the situation has become alarming in the neighbouring State of Assam;

Now, therefore, I Shri. Ramakhrisna Chitturi, IAS, District Magistrate, South West Garo Hills, Ampati in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144 Cr.P.C. read together with Regulation 3 of the Meghalaya Epidemic Disease, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 do hereby pass the **PROHIBITORY** order below to be effective with immediately effect:

1. All Inter-State border roads whether PWD road, PMGSY, MGNREGS, village road, public road etc shall be sealed.
2. Inter-State movement of all types of vehicles and people shall be restrained except FCI Trucks, Oil tankers, LPG tankers, Medicine Suppliers & other vehicles for which specific authority letters/permission have been are issued. These vehicles shall be allowed through designated routes subject to checking by the Police/Medical Team in the Check Points.
3. All vehicle passes issued to Pick-up trucks for distribution/supply of essential commodities is restricted to movement within the district only subject to checking by the Police/Medical Team in the Check Points and after taking necessary precautionary measures for social distancing and maintenance of hygiene and hand washing etc.
4. Inter-District movement of all types of vehicles without permit is not allowed within the district.

Further, all the Headmen/Nokmas of the villages located in the Meghalaya-Assam border are to inform all the residents of their respective villages not to cross the border for procuring Essential Commodities and vegetables, etc from Assam. They are also advised to refrain from meeting any donation agency without the authority of BDOs/Undersigned. For any assistance regarding essential commodities, etc during this lockdown period the Nokmas/Headmen may contact their respective Block Development Officers and Gram Sevak/Sevikas for necessary arrangement. **Public is directed not to come out without wearing mask or covering their mouth with handkerchief and are also advised not to spit on the public places.**

In view of the urgency of the matter, this order is passed exparte and it shall come into force with immediate effect until further orders.
